

Tobias Jacobsen was born with design in his genes. He is the grandson of world-famous Danish architect and designer Arne Jacobsen and has more than evidently inherited his grandfather's talent for design. A talent that is characterised by a minimalist design philosophy in which all superfluous elements are stripped away to reveal the pure form of the object itself. For Tobias Jacobsen, the story behind the product is also of vital importance in that the product must be created with consideration for both humans and the environment.

Tobias Jacobsen (born 1965) underwent formal training as a goldsmith and industrial designer at Danmarks Designskole. Today, he works with design in a wide range of areas that includes timepieces, jewellery, furniture, architecture and kitchenware.

With a burning passion for food, Tobias has the same kind of feelings for the design as he has for good soup. It is the love for the soup that makes it good, not the pots and pans. Design is about craftmanship, techniques and love for the products and their practical use.

JACOBSEN RADIO THE THOUGHTS BEHIND THE DESIGN

I wanted to make a design that expresses good sound with a shape that you would not get tired of looking at. The design should therefore be "quiet". It was not to "make too much noise" and attract too much attention. As I have before, I found inspiration in architecture. I love to watch the city skyline, the mirror facades, competing to be the tallest one.

This gave me the idea for the stringent, sculptural design, which, in its simplicity, offers the user optimal operation with its sloping surface.

The sound quality was to be wide and deep compared with the size of the shape. This made demands on the sound units. And, to avoid buttons, I demanded the latest technology.

To me, the surface or panel where you operate the radio is a starry sky which you can guide yourself around the sound universe — or memories, which music also represents.

I hope that with this design the radio will be a serving spirit, arousing memories, creating pictures and feelings and strengthening the senses of the listeners for a fuller life.
